E11/07 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

E12/07 COMMUNICATION RECEIVED BY THE CHAIRMAN

The Chairman read out a letter regarding the central refuge on Salisbury Road.

E13/07 PUBLIC TOILET FACILITIES

A range of possibilities of improving public toilet facilities in Maltby were explored.

RECOMMENDED: that the possibility of making an arrangement with the owners of the Indoor Market with regard to the joint use of the toilet facilities for the public be pursued.

E14/07 UPDATE FROM THE CLERK AND FINANCIAL OFFICER

The Clerk and Financial Officer confirmed that a) he had arranged to carry out risk assessment to be carried out on Manor Fields for the forthcoming Bonfire on Thursday 5 July at 2pm. In attendance will be Alan Hilary Events, Belmont Safety Services and the Clerk and Financial Officer b) he would chase up the missing planters on the High Street and c) in his opinion the Chairman and himself should visit Milton Street Allotments to assess the situation with the boundary fencing.
