E54/04 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

E55/04 MALTBY QUIZ NIGHT

RECOMMENDED: that the town council support a Maltby Quiz Night to
a limit of £200.00

E56/04 CHRISTMAS LIGHTS

Councillor B Slade commented on a Christmas illumination, which had
fallen on Tickhill Road. The Clerk & Financial Officer reported that he
had already arranged to meet a health and safety consultant to more
clearly specify the course of the action the council needs to take when
erecting Christmas illuminations. He commented that a thorough review
of the situation with regard to Christmas illuminations was required and
agreed to make a report to a future meeting of the committee when his
review was concluded.
