P49/04 REPORT FROM MALTBY CDT

Mr I Cruddas, Programme Manager of the Maltby CDT, in attendance.

Mr Cruddas gave a presentation on the development of the Wesley Centre and other initiatives currently being developed by the Maltby CDT.

P51/04 UPDATE ON THE PURCHASE OF THE EDWARD DUNN MEMORIAL HALL
